

1968, the effect of which is that the following lengths of road will be subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.:

1. That length of the Knaresborough and Wetherby County Road (B.6164), at Wetherby in the Rural District of Wetherby in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 125 yards south-east of its junction with Scriftain Lane in a general south-easterly direction to a point 90 yards north of the northerly side of its junction with the Wetherby-Rufforth-York County Road (B.1224), a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 1,620 yards.
2. That length of the Great Houghton and Hickleton County Road (B.6411) at Great Houghton in the Rural District of Hemsworth in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from the south-easterly side of its junction with Stonebridge Lane to a point 20 yards south-east of the south-easterly side of its junction with Wescoe Avenue, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 575 yards.

*B. The County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Restricted Roads) (No. 6) Order 1971.*

An Order under sections 72 (3), 73 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is that the length of road referred to in Schedule 1 below will cease to be subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. and that the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 2 below will become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.:

SCHEDULE 1

That length of Bradley Road at Silsden, in the Urban District of Silsden, in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 344 yards north-west of its junction with Bridge Street and Skipton Road West for a distance measured along the said length of road in a north-westerly direction of 325 yards.

SCHEDULE 2

1. That length of the Swillington and Allerton Bywater County Road (C.6) (Astley Lane) at Swillington in the Rural District of Tadcaster in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 390 yards south of its junction with the Huddersfield-Wakefield-Hook Moor County Road (A.642) for a distance measured along the said length of road in a southerly direction of 200 yards.

2. Those lengths of the Ripon, Burton Leonard and Staveley County Road (C.291) at Burton Leonard in the Rural District of Nidderdale in the County of York, West Riding, which extend from a point 105 yards north of its junction with Limekiln Lane to a point 213 yards north of the same junction and from a point 233 yards east of the easterly side of its junction with Straight Lane for a distance measured along the said length of road in an easterly direction of 65 yards.

3. That length of the Wormald Green and Burton Leonard County Road (C.292) (Station Lane) at Burton Leonard in the Rural District of Nidderdale in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 293 yards west of the westerly side of its junction with Scarah Lane for a distance measured along the said length of road in a westerly direction of 165 yards.

4. That length of Straight Lane (Unclassified) County Road at Burton Leonard in the Rural District of Nidderdale in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 60 yards north of its junction with Mill Lane for a distance measured along the said length of road in a northerly and easterly direction of 215 yards.

5. That length of Scarah Lane (Unclassified) County Road at Burton Leonard in the Rural District of Nidderdale in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 45 yards south of its junction with Station Lane for a distance measured along the said length of road in a southerly direction of approximately 345 yards.

6. That length of the Durkar-Walton-Crofton-Sharlston County Road (B.6378) at Crofton in the Rural District of Wakefield in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point immediately west of the westerly side of its junction with Thorntree Avenue for a distance measured along the said length of road in a generally south-westerly direction of approximately 250 yards.

7. That length of the Durkar-Walton-Crofton-Sharlston County Road (B.6378) at Durkar in the Rural District of Wakefield in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 200 yards east of the easterly side of its junction with News-holme Lane for a distance measured along the said length of road in a south-easterly direction of 100 yards.

8. That length of the Hemsworth and Badsworth County Road (C.148) at Badsworth in the Rural District of Hemsworth in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 130 yards west of the westerly side of its junction with Ninevah Lane to a point 20 yards north of its junction with the South Elmsall and Wentbridge County Road (B.6474) a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 690 yards.

9. That length of the Ninevah Lane (Unclassified) County Road at Badsworth in the Rural District of Hemsworth in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from its junction with new Road for a distance measured along the said length of road in a north-westerly direction of 450 yards.

10. That length of Back Lane (Unclassified) County Road at Badsworth, in the Rural District of Hemsworth in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from its south-easterly junction with the Hemsworth and Badsworth County Road (C.148) to its north-westerly junction with the Hemsworth and Badsworth County Road (C.148) a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 560 yards.

11. That length of the South Elmsall and Wentbridge County Road (B.6474) at Thorpe Audlin in the Rural District of Hemsworth in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 145 yards south-west of its junction with the Leeds-Pontefract-Barnsdale Bar County Road (A.639) to a point 365 yards south-west of the south-westerly side of its junction with Darning Lane, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 735 yards.

12. That length of the Manvers, Barnburgh and Brodsworth County Road (C.72) at Barnburgh in the Rural District of Doncaster in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 150 yards north-west of the north-westerly side of its junction with the entrance road to Barnburgh Hall to a point 280 yards north-west of the north-westerly side of its junction with Stables Lane, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 413 yards.

13. That length of the Goldthorpe, Barnburgh and Sprotbrough County Road (C.22) at Barnburgh in the Rural District of Doncaster in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from the eastern side of the junction of Fox Lane and Back Lane for a distance measured along the said length of road in a south-easterly direction of 170 yards.

14. That length of the Scawsby, Sprotbrough and Warmsworth County Road (C.235) at Sprotbrough in the Rural District of Doncaster in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from a point 449 yards north of its junction with the Goldthorpe, Bornburgh and Sprotbrough County Road (C.22) for a distance measured along the said length of road in a north-westerly direction of 140 yards.

*C. The County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire (40 m.p.h. speed limit) (No. 7) Order 1971.*

An Order under sections 72 (3), 73 (1), 74 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is that the following length of road will be subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.:

That length of the Ashton-Greenfield-Bleak Hey Nook County Road (A.670) known as Oldham Road at Greenfield in the Urban District of Saddleworth, in the County of York, West Riding, which extends from its junction with the Stockport-Ashton Road at Grasscroft in a general north-easterly direction to the southerly side of its junction with Chapel Road (A.6051) a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 1,267 yards.
