The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity. (i) smoke is carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.
- (ii) any person acquires any unauthorised solid fuel intending it to be used in a building in the smoke control areas, or in a boiler or plant in the smoke control areas, he shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding Twenty pounds.

If confirmed the Order will not come into opera-tion before 1st December 1972 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
