*North Wessex Downs Area of Outstanding
Natural Beauty (Designation) Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Countryside Commission propose to make and submit to the Department of the Environment for confirmation the above-mentioned Order.

2. The effect of the proposed Order, which will not come into operation until confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Environment will be to constitute the land to which the proposed Order relates an area of outstanding natural beauty for the

purposes of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.

3. The proposed Order relates to land situated in the Counties of Berkshire, Hampshire and Wiltshire and comprises land within the undermentioned districts:

The Rural Districts of Abingdon, Bradfield, Faringdon, Hungerford, Kingsclere and Whitchurch, Newbury, Wallingford, Wantage, Andover, Basingstoke, Calne and Chippenham, Cricklade and Wootton Bassett, Devizes, Highworth, Marlborough and Ramsbury, and Pewsey.

The Urban District of Wantage.

The Municipal Borough of Marlborough.

4. A copy of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein has been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Council of each of the areas mentioned above, and will be open for inspection, free of charge, during office hours. *Scheme for a new intake in the River Exe and a
Pumping Station*

Notice is hereby given that the above-mentioned Board is about to apply to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order under section 23 of the Water Act, 1945 authorising the construction of a new intake on the River Exe near Exeter and the erection of a pumping station and other ancillary works. The works to be carried out are within the City of Exeter and the Parish of Bramford Speke in the rural district of St. Thomas within the county of Devon.

The Board supplies water to the City and County of the City of Exeter and to parts of the counties of Devon, Dorset and Somerset. The constituent areas served by the Board include the City and County of the City of Exeter, the boroughs of Honiton and Lyme Regis, the urban districts of Budleigh Salterton, Exmouth, Ottery St. Mary, Seaton and Sidmouth, the rural districts of Axminster, Honiton and St. Thomas (part) and also a small part of the rural district of Chard in Somerset. The Board also provides fringe supplies in the borough of Chard, and the rural districts of Beaminster, Bridport, Crediton, Taunton and Tiverton.
