

eastern boundary of field parcel number 8118. Crossing the County highway, the line follows the Cadoxton River as far as field parcel 3673 and continues along the northern hedgerow.

Penarth

Land bounded by low water mark of the foreshore to the east and a general line formed by Raisdale Road to the junction of that road with Plymouth Road to the south, with the western boundary drawn generally to follow the rear of properties abutting Plymouth Road on its western side as far as the railway station.

The boundary continuing northwards to the junction of Stanwell Road with the lane to the rear of Rectory Road. Thence in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Windsor Terrace. The boundary from this point continues in a general easterly direction

following Beach Lane and extended to include the Kymyn and thence to lower water mark.

Documents including a map showing the precise boundaries of the designated areas have been deposited at the offices of the County Planning Officer, County Council Offices, Greyfriars Road, Cardiff also in respect of the first two areas, the office of the Clerk to Cardiff Rural District Council, 20 Park Place, Cardiff, and in respect to Penarth Conservation Area, the office of the Clerk to the Penarth Urban District Council, West House, Stanwell Road, Penarth, and may be inspected by the public at all reasonable hours.
