DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 to authorise the diversion of Franklands Lane, Framwellgate Moor, Co. Durham to enable development consisting of the extension of Low Newton Remand Centre and proposed prison at Brasside, Framwellgate Moor, Co. Durham to be carried out by the Home Office.

The proposed Order will require that the new length of highway which the Home Office has agreed to provide as the diversion is to be a highway maintainable at the public expense, for which the Highway Authority is to be the Durham County Council.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Cumberland) (No. 1) Order 1971" authorising the stopping-up of a length of unnamed road which connects the north-eastern and south-western arms of the peripheral road at Moor Place, Frizington, Cumberland.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1968 to authorise the stopping-up of lengths of Summer Hill, Laurel Lane and Great Cornbow, Halesowen, Worcestershire in the interests of the safety of users of and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the Queensway—A.459 link road (which is a highway to be constructed in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962).
