## HOVE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Hove (Parking Places and Traffic Regulation) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Hove Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") propose to make an Order under sections 35, 36, 37, 39 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the general effect of which will be as follows:

- 1. to designate and control the use of parking places, for which charges may be made, in those streets, or parts of streets, against which the number (1) appears in Schedule 1 to this Notice and to authorise the issue of a permit for one vehicle, being either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle, belonging to any resident of Hove whose usual place of abode is at any premises in any of the said streets, or parts of streets, for the unlimited use of any such parking place on payment of the prescribed charge;
- 2. to provide and control the use of street parking places, without charges, in those streets, or parts of streets, against which the number (2) and/or (3) appears in the said Schedule, the number (2) indicating that the parking places may be used by passenger vehicles and goods vehicles only and for a maximum waiting period of 1 hour in 2 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, being a public holiday, but otherwise without limitation of time; the number (3) indicating that the parking places may be used by passenger vehicles and goods vehicles only for a maximum waiting period of 2 hours in 3 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, being a public holiday, but otherwise without limitation of time. of time:
- 3. to provide and control the use of street parking places, without charges, in those streets, or parts of streets, against which the number (4) appears in the said Schedule, the number (4) indicating that the parking places may be used by motor cycles only and on any day without limitation of time;
- 4. to prohibit waiting at all times in specified lengths of Church Road, Cromwell Road and those streets, or parts of streets, against which the number (5) appears in the said Schedule;
- 5. to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, being a public holiday, in the lengths of those streets, or parts of streets, specified in the said Schedule which will not comprise part of a parking place or be subject to a prohibition of waiting at all times;
- 6. to make the streets and parts of streets specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Notice one-way streets and to require vehicles therein not to proceed otherwise than in the direction specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule opposite each such street or part of a street;
- 7. to authorise a charge of £7.50 for a permit for a period of 12 calendar months and to provide for an appropriate refund in any of the events psecified in the proposed Order whereby the permit is surrendered, withdrawn or otherwise rendered invalid before its expiry;

- to authorise the following extemptions to the provisions of the proposed Order:
   (i) any passenger vehicle or goods vehicle may wait in any designated parking place referred to in 1 above, without a permit, for any period of 2 hours in 3 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, being a public holiday, and otherwise without limitation of time;
- (ii) any invalid carriage or any vehicle displaying an authorisation to wait, indicating that the driver is a disabled person, may wait in any designated parking place referred to in 1 above, without a permit, and in any street parking place referred to in 2 above, and in any length of street referred to in 5 above, in
- in any street parking place referred to in 2 above, and in any length of street referred to in 5 above, in each case without limitation of time; and

  (iii) any vehicle may wait in any of the said designated parking places, without a permit, and in any of the street parking places referred to in 2 and 3 above, and in any length of street referred to in 4 and 5 above, at any time when the vehicle is waiting to enable any person to board or alight, being used for public utility, Post Office, fire brigade, police, ambulance or local authority purposes, or for window or chimney cleaning, bill posting, street works, furniture removal or the collection or delivery of goods or merchandise;
- 9. to authorise the following provisions of the proposed Order: its commencement, citation and interpretation, the revocation of certain provisions of subsisting Orders of the Council, the application for, form of, issue, display, surrender, withdrawal and validity of permits and duplicate permits, the placing of traffic signs, the manner of standing, waiting and use of vehicles in parking places, the movement in or removal of vehicles from parking places in emergencies, the suspension of the use of parking places and the restriction of the use of vehicles in parking places.
- 10. A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the streets or parts of streets and the provisions referred to in this Notice, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and copies of the Orders containing the provisions to be revoked, and maps, may be inspected at the undermentioned address between the hours of 8.45 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and 2.15 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.
- 11. Any objection to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which it is made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned not later than 12th October 1971.
