TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Lancaster) (No. 7) Order 1971" authorising the stopping up of a length of Westwick Place, Huyton, Liverpool.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968
