Notice is hereby given that on 27th October 1971, the Norwich City Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

This Order will come into operation on 29th October 1971, and its effect is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in Marlpit Lane on its west side from its junction with Dercham

between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in Maripit Lane on its west side from its junction with Dereham Road to its junction with Knowfand Grove and on its east side from its junction with Dereham Road to a point 50 metres north of that junction. The Order is being brought into operation in conjunction with an Order made by the Department of the Environment restricting waiting in Dereham Road itself. Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of nicking up and setting down passengers, loading of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, and, where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply

of gas, electricity and water.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road to which it applies is available at my office at the City Hall, Norwich, where it may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 27th October 1971, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
