Poringland Public Path Diversion Order, 1971

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th October 1971, the Norfolk County Council confirmed the above-named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of the public right of way running from Rectory Lane in the Parish of Poringland in a westerly direction for approximately 500 feet along the northern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 259 to a line commencing at Rectory Lane at the same point as the existing path and running firstly along the western boundary of Rectory Lane to join the footway along the northern side of St. Mary's Road and finally rejoining the remaining section of the existing path 40 feet to the north-west of the western most part of the turning circle at the end of St. Mary's Road.
