If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Wiltshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, them-selves confirm the Order. If the Order is sub-mitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
