ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

CHELMSFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

(A) *The Borough of Chelmsford (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 197*

(B) *The Borough of Chelmsford (Various Streets) (One Way) Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Chelmsford acting by the Council of the said Borough propose to make the above mentioned Orders under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967. The effect of the Order referred to at (A) will be to:—

- (a) revoke The Borough of Chelmsford (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 insofar as it relates to any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto;
- (b) prohibit or restrict the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of roads specified in columns (1), (2) and (3) of the said First Schedule hereto between the hours specified opposite to those lengths in columns (4) and (5) of such Schedule with savings so far as Goldlay Road and Rochford Road are concerned in respect of vehicles waiting in those lengths thereof opposite which a period is specified in column (6) of such Schedule for no longer than such period.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purposes of

- (i) delivering or collecting postal packets;
- (ii) picking up or setting down passengers;
- (iii) loading or unloading goods; or
- (iv) where necessary to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads or any services therein;
- and by disabled persons' vehicles as required by The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1971.

The effect of the Order referred to at (B) above will be to introduce one way working over the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, vehicles to proceed only in the direction specified opposite to those lengths in the second column of the said Second Schedule.

A copy of the proposed Orders, maps showing the length of roads to which the proposed Orders relate and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the office of the undersigned during normal office hours to whom objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing by the 29th November 1971.
