The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Any person who acquires any solid fuel, other than authorised fuels, for use in a building, fireplace, boiler or plant within the smoke control area, otherwise than in a building, fireplace, boiler or plant exempted from operation of section 11 of the Clean exempted from operation of section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, or who sells by retail any solid fuel, other than authorised fuel, for delivery by him or on his behalf to a building within the area or to premises within the area in which there is a boiler or plant not exempted as stated above, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £20.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1972, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
