#### Commendation

Lieutenant Christopher Stafford Gobby, Royal Navy, for his bravery and determination in bringing to safety the entire crew of the Chinese fishing vessel Chung Yu, grounded on a reef off the Seychelles on 4th July. Conditions were too bad for even a gemini to approach the reef and it was decided to use the two inflatable liferafts. One of these broke loose and at great risk to himself from drowning and without pausing to inflate his life-jacket, Lieutenant Gobey dived overboard into the heavy, shark-infested surf and retrieved it.
