ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

Imposition of 40 m.p.h. speed limit

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment intends to make an Order under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, prohibiting the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Part of this length of road i.e. from 60 yards north of its junction with Cheriton Road to its southern junction with Cherry Garden Lane is at present subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.

Any objection to the making of the Order should be sent to the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), Department of the Environment, "Edgeborough", Epsom Road, Guildford, Surrey, not later than the 25th January 1972, quoting the reference number DSE 224/28/1/TR 4/02. SCHEDULE

Length of the London—Folkestone—Dover Trunk Road (A.20) in the Borough of Folkestone, Kent, which extends from a point 60 yards north of its junction with Cheriton Road to a point 123 yards north of its junction with Links Way, a distance of approximately 1,040 yards.

The Trunk Road (Dymchurch Road, St. Mary-in-the-Marsh) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972

The Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to extend the existing restriction on waiting of vehicles in the Folkestone - Brighton - Southampton - Dorchester - Honiton Trunk Road known as Dymchurch Road, St. Mary-in-the-Marsh in the Rural District of Romney Marsh, in the County of Kent.

The proposed Order will now restrict waiting on the south-eastern side of Dymchurch Road from a point 40 yards north-east of its junction with Sea Way Road to a point 233 yards south-west of its junction with Jefferstone Lane between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 8 p.m. during the period from 1st April to 30th September, both days inclusive.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition,
