

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to extinguish the public rights of way over the footpath running from point A on the deposited plan, which point is approximately 43 yards to the rear and south-west of the "Bird in Hand" Public House, Paul Street, Coseley, to point B on the said plan, which point is approximately 93 yards to the north-east of point A, and to create an alternative footpath commencing at the said point A and extending in an easterly direction for approximately 90 yards to point C on the said plan.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment has considered the proposals contained in the First Review of the County of Essex Development Plan submitted by the Council in 1965 relating to the Urban District of Wivenhoe and part of the Tendring Rural District.

Based on the information at present before him he considers that the proposals should be modified.

Lists of the Secretary of State's proposed modifications have been deposited for public inspection at the Council Offices, Wivenhoe; the Council Offices, Weeley, and at County Hall, Chelmsford (Room 107, Tower Block "A"), and may be seen between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.
