The Trunk Road (Bridgend By-Pass) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales intends to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be:
