BRIERFIELD URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

The Brierfield (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Brierfield Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 9th March 1972, made an Order entitled The Brierfield (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1972, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister for the Department of the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels include electricity.

If confirmed the Order will come into operation on the 1st July 1973, or on such other date as may
