ILKESTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Ilkeston (St. Mary Street and Chapel Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that on the 25th April 1972 the Ilkeston Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is:

(a) to prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto; and

(b) to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than Sunday in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

The Order comes into force on the 1st June 1972.

The Order amends the Borough of Ilkeston (Town Centre and adjoining streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1972, in so far as it relates to the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto.

The Order contains the usual exceptions.
