in connection with the above-mentioned Scheme and Orders.

The said Scheme would, if made,

- (a) provide that the road which the Secretary of b) provide that the road which the Secretary of State proposes to construct for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1959 (as amended) will be a special road about 14.29 kilometres in length between Capel Llanilltern in the County of Glamorgan and Pencoed in the said County;
- (b) provide 8 special roads as connecting roads between the above-mentioned Special Road and the proposed new link road to Llantrisant and the proposed Pencoed By-Pass, and
- (c) provide for the special roads to become trunk roads as from the date when the scheme comes into operation.

The first said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State:

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;

(b) stop up highways;

- (c) to construct new highways;
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and

(e) to provide new private means of access to premises ;

all in the vicinity of the above-mentioned special roads, and

Provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Glamorgan as from 1st April next after the date on which the Secretary of State notifies that authoirty that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

The second said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State to purchase compulsorily:

(a) the land and rights described in Schedule 1 thereof for the purpose of:

(i) the construction of new special roads in the Parishes of Coychurch Lower, Pencoed St. Mary Hill, Llanilid, Llansannor, Llanharry, Llantrisant, Pendoylan, Peterson-Super-Ely and Llanilterne in the County of Glamorgan in pur-suance of the M.4 Motorway (Capel Llaniltern to Pencoed Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme 197;

(ii) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access in the said Parishes in pursuance of the M4 Motorway (Capel Llanilltern to Pencoed Section) and Connecting Roads (Side Roads) Order 197;

(iii) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in the said County in connection with the construction of special roads, the construction and improve-ment of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned in the foregoing sub-paragraphs; and

(iv) use by the Secretary of State in connec-tion with such construction and improvement of highways as such execution of other works as aforesaid.

(b) the land described in Schedule 2 hereto for the purpose of the provision of a maintenance compound in connection with the special road at Pencoed in the said County.

The Secretary of State hereby directs that any person who intends at the inquiry to submit that any highway or proposed highway to which the draft Scheme or Orders relate should follow an alternative Scheme or Orders relate should follow an alternative route, or that, instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which the draft Orders relate, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route, shall send to him at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newpont Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU not later than 6th June 1972 sufficient in-formation about the alternative route or the route of the new highway, as the case may be, to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the Secretary of State and the person holding the Inquiry to disregard so much of person holding the Inquiry to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
