## The Borough of Gosport (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council propose to make an Order under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to regulate the use of the parking places for vehicles specified in the Schedule to this notice. The Order includes provision for:

- (a) The conduct of persons in the parking places;
