The Trunk Road (Bridgend By-Pass) (Prohibition of Right-hand Turn) Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is:—

- i. that no person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in a westerly direction in the length of road described in the Schedule below to make a right-hand turn into Merthyr Mawr Road (North); and
- ii. that no person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in an easterly direction in the length of road described in the Schedule below to make a right-hand turn into Merthyr Mawr Road (South).

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State,

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or if any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 10th May 1972 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

That length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A48), known as the Bridgend By-Pass at Bridgend in the County of Glamorgan, which extends from its junction with Ewenny Road to its junction with New Inn Road.
