HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The M.4 Motorway (Pencoed to Stormy Down Section) (Connecting Roads) Scheme 197

The M.4 Motorway (Pencoed to Stormy Down Section Side Roads) Order 197

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make:

1. A Scheme under section 11 of the Highways Act 1959, authorising him to provide for the exclusive use of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1959 (as amended) four special roads as connecting roads between the Special Road which he proposes to construct between Pencoed in the County of Glamorgan and Stormy Down in the said County and the proposed interchange at Cefn Hirgoed; and providing for the appendic roads to become truth roads providing for the special roads to become trunk roads on the date when the scheme comes into operation; and

2. An Order under section 13 of the Highways Act 1959 which will, in relation to that part of the M.4 Motorway which will be situated between Pencoed and Stormy Down in the County of Glamorgan: (a) authorise him:

(i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter (ii) to stop up highways;
(iii) to construct new highways;
(iv) to stop up private means of access to

premises, and

premises, and (v) to provide new means of access to premises all on or in the vicinity of the route of the above-mentioned part of the said Motorway, and (b) provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Glamorgan as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been comthe Council that the new highway has been com-pleted and is open for through traffic.
