#### SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL

##### *Restriction and Prohibition of Waiting in Massetts Road and Povey Cross Road, Horley*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Administrative County of Surrey have made orders under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When these Orders come into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at the times and in the lengths of Massetts Road and Povey Cross Road, Horley, in the Rural District of Dorking and Horley referred to in the Schedule hereto.

The usual exceptions for loading and unloading goods and for statutory undertakers' vehicles will apply.

The Orders will come into operation on 3rd July 1972 and together with a plan showing the lengths of roads to which they relate can be inspected at the County Deeds Office (Room 119), County Hall, Kingston upon Thames, during normal office hours.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders on the ground that they are not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or any regulations made under those sections has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within six weeks of the date on which the Orders are made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

#### SUNDERLAND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

##### *The County Borough of Sunderland (Street Parking Places) Order, 1972*

Notice is hereby given that the Sunderland County Borough Council has made an Order under section 28 (1), 31 (1), 35 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The Order will authorise the use of parts of the roads named in the Schedule to this notice as free

parking places for motor cars, motor cycles and invalid carriages between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Parking will be limited to one hour in any period of two hours in any one parking place and lights will not be required during the hours of darkness.

At the discretion of the Council, an exemption permit may be issued to business interests or others where it is considered that a particular hardship is created by the measures or where arrangements are necessary to satisfy difficulties which might be peculiar
