PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT 1931

Regulations made by the Architects Registration Council of the United Kingdom under section 13 of the above-mentioned Act have been submitted for the approval of the Privy Council and are published herewith.

Representations by persons to whom the Regulations are applicable may be made in writing to the Privy Council on or before the 5th day of August 1972. 1972.

Architects Registration Council of the United Kingdom Regulations made in pursuance of section 13 of the Architects (Registration) Act 1931, amending the existing Regulations.

Amend paragraphs (3), (4) and (5) of Regulation 45 to read as follows:

read as follows:.
"(3) In the ensuing month of November the Clerk shall send by post to each unattached Architect whose name is entered in the Voters' List at his address appearing in the Register a notice containing the particulars following, viz.:
(a) A statement of the number of unattached Architects whose names appear in the Voters' List

- (b) A statement of the appropriate number of members of the Council to be elected by such
-) The names of such of the members of the Council elected under the said sub-paragraph (c) (vii) and holding office on the said 31st day of October as are willing (if nominated and elected) to continue in office for a further year together with a record of their respective attend-ances at meetings of the Council, Committees and Panels from the last preceding annual meeting down to the said 31st day of October.
- (d) An invitation to the addressee to sign and transmit to the Clerk at the Office of the Council so as to be received by him not later than the ensuing 1st day of January (upon a form of nomination to be enclosed with the

notice) nominations (to a number not exceeding the appropriate number) of registered persons for election as members of the Council for the year commencing at the close of the ordinary meeting to be held in the ensuing month of March together with a consent and statement under the hand of every such nominee ex-pressing his willingness (if elected) to serve as such member for the said period and giving for the information of voters on the unattached list the following information about himself (limited to not more than 100 words):

(i) Age.

(ii) Date of Admission to the Register of Architects.

(iii) Names of Architectural Constituent Bodies of which Candidate is a member (if any).

(iv) Present professional post (including the name of the firm or employer) and previous professional experience.

(v) Committee experience (Architectural or otherwise).

(e) A statement that nominations must be received from not less than six unattached Architects in respect of each candidate: a candidate may not nominate himself.

(f) A statement that nominations must be made on the official form enclosed with this notice.

(4) In the said month of January the Clerk shall (4) In the said month of January the Clerk shall send by post to each person whose name is entered on the Voters' List at his address appearing in the Register a voting paper containing a list (arranged alphabetically in the order of their surname) of the candidates in respect of whom such nominations and consents and statements have been received on or before the first day of that month and con-raining also the emtements hereinsfrar mentioned taining also the statements hereinafter mentioned.

(5) There shall be enclosed with each voting paper:

(a) The statement giving information about him-self received from each candidate in accord-ance with paragraph 3 (d) of this regulation, and
