The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under sections 3 (6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act, 1958, viz.: The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 8) Order 1972.

This Order provides that 1, 3-Dichloro-5, 5 dimethylhydantion shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 1st September 1972, and that the goods listed in the Schedule shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 2nd October 1972.

The Order comes into operation on 19th July 1972, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1972 No. 1057.

This Order alters the form of the subheadings of heading 20.09 of the Customs Tariff 1959 to facilitate the implementation of Kennedy Round reductions in the revenue duty on certain imported spirits but not on Rum.
