## LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of Liverpool Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool proposes to make the following Orders under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 9 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968:

## Order

- (Admiral Street/Windsor Street/North Hill Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order.
- (South Street/Devonshire Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order.
- (Linnet Lane/Ivanhoe Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order.

- (Queens Drive/Alder Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order.

- (b) Queens Drive, the east and west carriageways—from a point 46 metres (151 feet) north of its junction with Alder Road for a distance of 116 metres (381 feet) in a southerly direction.
- (Toft Street) (Prohibition of Driving) Order.
- To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in Toft Street unless requiring access to premises in or adjacent to Toft Street.
- (Town Row/Leyfield Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order.
- To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles :
- (a) at any time in any of the lengths of road speci-fied in Schedule 4 to this Notice;
- (b) between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Mondays to Satur-days inclusive in any of the lengths of road or sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice; and
- (c) for more than 1 hour in any period of 2 hours between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Mondays to Satur-days inclusive on the southwest side of Town Row:-
  - (i) from a point 5 metres (16 feet) southeast of its junction with Marlfield Road to a point 5 metres (16 feet) northwest of its junction with Norris Green Road; and
  - (ii) from a point 5 metres (16 feet) southeast of its junction with Bonsall Road to a point 5 metres (16 feet) northwest of its junction with Hartington Road.
- (Newsham Park) (Experimental Prohibition of Driving) Order.
- To prohibit any vehicle from entering or leaving any of the roads specified in the first column of Schedule 6 to this Notice at the junction specified in the second column of that Schedule.
- To prohibit any vehicle, except vehicles in use by the local authority or Public Utility Opera-tors or the emergency services, from proceeding in any of the lengths of road specified in Sched-ule 7 to this Notice.

The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary (a) for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, (c) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road, or sides of lengths of road and (d) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, provided that no vehicle (other than a vehicle being used

## Effect of Order

To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in any of the lengths of road or sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

To prohibit, with certain exceptions the waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of road or sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice.

- To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Queens Drive) (No waiting) Order, 1968 in so far as it relates to that length of Queens Drive, Stoneycroft, (the east and west carriageways) which extends from a point 46 metres (151 feet) north of its junction with Alder Road for a distance of 116 metres (381 feet) in a southerly direction. 1.
- To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in:—
- (a) Alder Road—from its junction with Queens Drive to a point 46 metres (151 feet) east of that junction; and
