RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES

The Treasury hereby give notice that in accordance with the powers conferred upon them by the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 c. 13) the following rates of interest shall be charged on loans made by the Public Works Loan Commissioners on and after 19th August 1972.

Loans to local authorities as defined in paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the said Act.

The amount which an authority borrows within its annual quota as determined by the said Commissioners will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the lower set of rates. Where authorities borrow further sums these will attract interest in the higher set of rates, unless the said Commissioners agree that they should be offset against the following year's quota. Different rates of interest apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity.

And the company by its counsel undertaking by the 1st October 1972 to forward to the Registrar of Companies as required by sections 124 and 126 of the Companies Act 1948 a copy of the annual return of the company for each of the years 1968 to 1971 (inclusive) together with the documents annexed thereto as required by section 127 of the said Act, to give to the Registrar of Companies as required by section 107 of the said Act notice of any change in the situation of the registered office of the company and to send to the Registrar of Companies as required by section 200 of the said Act a notification of any change among the directors of the company or in its secretary or in any of the particulars contained in its register of directors and secretaries specifying the date of the change

And the petitioner the said William James Greggor by his counsel undertaking to use his best endeavours to procure that the company do carry out its undertaking to the Court

This Court doth order that the name of the above named Admiral's Court Management Co. Limited be restored to the register of companies

And it is ordered that an office copy of this order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the said Admiral's Court Management Co. Limited is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
