HARTLEPOOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

The County Borough of Hartlepool No. 23 Smoke Control Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Hartlepool in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 23rd August 1972 made an Order entitled *The County Borough of Hartlepool No. 23 Smoke Control Order 1972*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1973 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Municipal Buildings, Hartlepool, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 31st August 1972.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB object to the confirmation of the Order.
