The Order becomes operative as from 9th October 1972, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within

the powers of the Highways Act, 1959 as amended, or any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9th October 1972, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
