The City Council of Liverpool Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool proposes to make the following Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968:

1. Hornby Close (Prohibition of Entry) Order To prohibit any vehicle proceeding in Hornby Road from entering Hornby Close, unless requiring access to premises in or adjacent to Hornby Close.

4. Swan Street (Restriction of Waiting) Order To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in Swan Street from its junc-tion with Prescot Road to a point 55 metres (180 feet) north of that junction.

5. Waldgrave Road/Northway (Restriction of Waiting) Örder

To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in:

(i) Waldgrave Road, the south side, from its junc-tion with Northway to a point 60 metres (197 feet) east of that junction; and
