The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865 (1865 c. 73) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) (Third Amendment) Order 1972.

Interpretation
