#### Y SWYDDFA GYMREIG

*The Trunk Road (Station Hill and Quay Road, Goodwick) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1972*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule below.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Roads Division (Y Swyddfa Gymreig, Adran Ffyrdd), Graham Buildings, 139 Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, quoting the reference R15/232/6.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 16th October 1972 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### SCHEDULE

That length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A.40), known in part as Station Hill and in part as Quay Road at Goodwick in the County of Pembroke, which extends from a point 103 yards south-east of the junction of Station Hill and Quay Road to a point 25 yards north-east of that junction.
