(1) *2 tons Weight Restriction*

Goods vehicles exceeding 2 tons unladen weight will be prohibited from using Chesham Road between its junction with High Street and Kingshill Way.

This Order will not apply to those vehicles requiring access to premises situated along the route. The alternative route for goods vehicles exceeding 2 tons unladen weight is via Kings Road.

(2) *One-Way System*
