#### STOKE-ON-TRENT CITY COUNCIL

##### *City of Stoke-on-Trent Traffic Regulation (No. 14) Order, 1972*

Notice is hereby given that the Stoke-on-Trent City Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The effect of the Order will be to:

##### *30 m.p.h. Speed Limit Order—Sudbury*

Notice is hereby given that the West Suffolk County Council propose to make an Order under section 72 (3) and section 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

##### *The Administrative County of West Sussex (Pulborough: Broomershill Lane) (Width Restriction) Order, 1972*

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds 6 feet 9 inches, in the following length of road in the Rural District of Chanctonbury:

The entire length of Broomershill Lane, in the Parish of Pulborough, from its junction with the London—Bognor Regis Road (A.29), southwards to its junction with the Pulborough—Storrington Road (A.283).

##### *The Administrative County of West Sussex (Broadbridge Heath: Horsham—Five Oaks Road (A.264) and Church Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1972*

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at all times in the following lengths of road, in the Parish of Horsham Rural:

Horsham—Five Oaks Road (A.264), Broadbridge Heath, south side, from a point 65 yards east of the eastern kerb line at its junction with Church Road, westwards for a distance of 120 yards.
