*The Trunk Road (Bridge Street, Dolgellau)
(Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1972*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the east side of that length of the Fishguard-Aberystwyth-Dolgellau-Caernarvon-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A.487) known as Bridge Street, at Dolgellau in the County of Merioneth, which extends from its junction with Smithfield Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 40 yards.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
