- 17. Eleanor Way, between the northern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and a point 60 feet north of that kerbline.
- . Forest Road, between the eastern kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 120 feet north-east of that kerbline.
- 19. Gews Corner, between the eastern kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 80 feet north of that
- 20. Hanbury Close, between the eastern kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 40 feet east of that kerbline.
- 21. Hedworth Avenue, between the western kerbline of High Street, Waltham Cross, and a point 60 feet west of that kerbline.
- 22. High Street, Cheshunt, between its junction with Warwick Drive and its junction with Turners Hill, excluding the lay-bys

  - (ii) adjacent to the junction with Warwick Drive and fronting Nos. 61-71 High Street, Cheshunt, (ii) adjacent to the junction with Cadmore Lane and fronting Nos. 64-72 High Street, Cheshunt, (iii) fronting Nos. 42-48 High Street, Cheshunt.
- 23. High Street, Waltham Cross

(a) between its junction with Crossbrook Street and a point 100 feet north of the northern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road,

- (b) between a point 160 feet south of the northern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and the boundary between the urban district of Cheshunt and the London Borough of Enfield.
- . Lodge Crescent, between the western kerbline of High Street, Waltham Cross, and a point 175 feet west of that kerbline.
- 25. Longcroft Drive, between the southern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and a point 60 feet south of that kerbline.
- 26. Montayne Road, between the western kerbline of Crossbrook Street and a point 60 feet west of that
- 27. Park Lane, Waltham Cross, between the western kerbline of High Street, Waltham Cross, and a point 300 feet west of that kerbline.
- 28. Queens Drive, between the southern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and a point 60 feet south of that kerbline.
- 29. Rowlands Close, the east side, between the northern kerbline of College Road and a point 60 feet north of that kerbline.
- 30. Rushleigh Avenue, between the southern kerbline of College Road and a point 60 feet south of that
- Russells Ride, between the eastern kerbline of Crossbrook Street and a point 60 feet east of that kerbline.
- 32. Station Approach, between the southern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and a point 40 feet south of that kerbline.
- 33. Swanfield Road, between the eastern kerbline of High Street, Waltham Cross, and a point 90 feet east of that kerbline.
- 34. Theobalds Lane, between the western kerbline of Crossbrook Street and a point 150 feet west of that kerbline.
- 35. Trinity Lane, between the eastern kerbline of High Street, Waltham Cross, and a point 420 feet south-east of that kerbline.
- 5. Turners Hill, between its junction with High Street, Cheshunt, and a point 20 feet north of a point opposite the panty wall of Nos. 18-20 Turners Hill, excluding the lay-bys

  (i) between Blindmans Lane and Church Lane,

  - (ii) opposite the junction with Forest Road and fronting Nos. 221-225 Turners Hill, (iii) opposite the junction with Windmill Lane and fronting Nos. 89-95 Turners Hill.
- 37. Warwick Drive, between the western kerbline of High Street, Cheshunt, and a point 60 feet north west of that kerbline.
- 38. Windmill Lane
  - (a) the north side
    - (i) between the eastern kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 300 feet east of that kerbline;
    - (ii) between a point 50 feet west of its junction with Delamare Road and a point 50 feet west of the level crossing gates.

(b) the south side
(i) between the eastern kerbline of Turners
Hill and a point 50 feet east of that kerbline;
(ii) between a point 50 feet west of its junction with Delamare Road and the boundary of British Rail Car Park.

- 2. York Road, between the northern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and a point 60 feet north of that kerbline.
- Access road between Nos. 54 and 58 Abbey Road, between the northern kerblines of Abbey Road and a point 60 feet north of that kerbline.
- 41. The carriageway immediately surrounding the circular island site at the junction of Turners Hill and College Road.

## Part III

No person shall cause a vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. inclusive, and between the hours of 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. inclusive, in the following roads:

1. Crossbrook Street

- (a) between its junction with Turners Hill and a point opposite the southern flank wall of No. 149 Crossbrook Street, excluding the lay-by between Hillside Avenue and Walnut Tree Close.
- (b) between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 131-133 Crossbrook Street and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 64-66 Crossbrook Street, excluding the lay-by opposite Nos. 115-127 Crossbrook Street.
- 2. Hillside Avenue, between the western kerbline of Crossbrook Stret and a point 60 feet west of that
- 3. Laburnum Close, between the western kerbline of Crossbrook Street and a point 60 feet west of that kerbline.
- 4. Limes Road, between the eastern kerbline of Crossbrook Street and a point 60 feet east of that kerbline.
- 5. Turners Hill, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 18-20 Turners Hill and its junction with Crossbrook Street.
- 6. Walnut Tree Close, between the western kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 60 feet west of that kerbline.

## SCHEDULE 2

## Part I

No person shall cause a vehicle to be loaded or unloaded at any time of the day or night throughout the week in the following roads:

High Street, Waltham Cross, between a point 100 feet north of the northern kerbline of Eleanor Cross Road and a point 160 feet south of that kerbline, excluding that section of carriageway immediately west of the Queen Eleanor Memorial bounded on the north and south sides by two traffic islands.
- Eleanor Cross Road, between the eastern kerbline of High Street, Waltham Cross, and a point 180 feet east of that kerbline.

## Part II

No person shall cause a vehicle to be loaded or unloaded between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. inclusive, and between the hours of 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. inclusive, in the following roads:

- 1. Albury Ride, between the western kerbline of Crossbrook Street and a point 60 feet west of that kerbline.
- 2. Blindmans Lane
- (a) the east side, between the western kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 200 feet south of that kerbline;
- (b) the west side, between the western kerbline of Turners Hill and a point 130 feet south of that kerbline.
- 3. Cadmore Lane
  - (a) the north side, between the eastern kerbline of High Street, Cheshunt, and its junction with
  - Lawrance Gardens;
    (b) the south side, between the eastern kerbline of High Street, Cheshunt, and its junction with Penton Drive.
- 4. Cecil Road, between the eastern kerbline of Cross-brook Street and a point 60 feet east of that kerbline.
