

(d) To prohibit vehicles entering or leaving Nicholas Street at its junction with the north-easterly side of Tockholes Road.

(e) To prohibit vehicles entering or leaving Britten Street at its junction with the north-easterly side of Harwood Street.

(f) To prohibit vehicles entering or leaving Alexandra View at its junction with the north-westerly side of Alexandra Road.

(g) To prohibit vehicles entering or leaving Crewdson Street at its junction with the south-westerly side of Hindle Street.

3. To prohibit through traffic in that part of north-westerly Back Alexandra Road at the rear of the properties numbered 22-32 Alexandra Road.

The Orders mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 will contain exemptions for vehicles used in connection with the emergency or public services.

Copies of the draft Orders and maps together with a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Orders may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours at the Town Clerk's Department, Municipal Buildings, Darwen, BB3 1BQ.

Any person who wishes to object to the Orders, or to any one of them, should do so within 21 days from the date of this notice. Objections to the Orders should be sent in writing to me at the above address and should set out the grounds for objection.

DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Derbyshire County Council (Winster Place and Marlow Street, Buxton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972.

Notice is hereby given that on the 23rd November 1972 the Derbyshire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is:

- To prohibit waiting between midnight and 8 a.m. on the south-east side of Marlow Street, Buxton.
- To restrict waiting between 8 a.m. and midnight to 1 hour with a prohibition on return within 2 hours on the south-east side of Marlow Street, Buxton.
- To revoke the Derbyshire County Council (Winster Place and Marlow Street, Buxton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971.

The Order will come into operation on the 8th December 1972.

Certificates of exemption will be issued to residents of Marlow Street in approved cases.

Exceptions are provided in the Order which will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, the maintenance of the roads and sewers, the supply of gas, electricity and water, installation and maintenance of telegraphic lines, the delivery and collection of postal packets, in connection with funerals and the taking in of petrol, water or air from a garage.

The Order also provides for disabled drivers' vehicles used for conveying disabled persons displaying badges in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1971.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the County Offices, Matlock (Room 109), and at the Town Hall, Buxton, during normal office hours (9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the 23rd of November 1972 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

ECCLES BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Eccles (Bradburn Street and Vine Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Eccles Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

When this Order comes into operation it will have the effect of prohibiting the waiting of vehicles at all times on lengths of Bradburn Street and Vine Street in the Borough of Eccles.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- picking up and setting down passengers,
- loading or unloading goods,
- funerals,

and, where necessary, in connection with:

ECCLES BOROUGH COUNCIL

Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th November 1972, the Eccles Borough Council made the following Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, which will come into operation on the 15th January 1973:

- The Borough of Eccles (Wilfred Road) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1972, which prohibits vehicles exceeding 2 tons laden or unladen weight from proceeding in Wilfred Road in the Borough of Eccles. Exemptions are provided for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to Wilfred Road and in connection with the maintenance of the roads and the supply of gas, water or electricity.
- The Borough of Eccles (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1972, which prohibits vehicles from proceeding in Blandford Road, Colborne Avenue, Gillingham Road and Slater Street in the Borough of Eccles unless requiring access to premises situated on or adjacent to these roads.

Copies of the Orders and the maps showing the restricted roads are available at the Town Hall, Eccles, where they may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or of any of the provisions contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, you may, within six weeks from the 20th November 1972, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
