Exceptions will be provided in the Orders to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary in the lengths of road referred to in Schedules I, II and III for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, for any funeral, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the service therein. Exception will be pro-vided in the Order in relation to the road referred to in Schedule IV for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from premises in the roads referred to control of the pro-
