The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notive that they have made an Order under section 26 of the Finance Act 1972 viz: The Value Added Tax (Terminal Markets) Order 1973.

This Order zero-rates certain supplies of goods and services in the course of dealings on the terminal markets listed in Article 2 (2) of the Order, which involve goods ordinarily deal't with on the market. Supplies which are zero-rated are futures transactions (including options) not resulting in a delivery of goods, provided they are supplies by or to a member of one of the markets; and sales of physical goods between members of one market subject to certain conditions laid down in Article 3 (2) (b). The Order also zero-rates the services of any market member acting as a broker in connection with any of these supplies.

The Order comes into operation on 1st April 1973 and has been published as Statutory Instrument 1973 No. 173.
