HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road and Raglan-Llandovery Trunk Road (Brecon By-Pass) Order, 197

The Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road and Raglan-Llandovery Trunk Road (Brecon By-Pass Side Roads) Order, 197

The Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

- 1. An Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959
- (a) that roads which he proposes to construct at Brecon in the county of Brecon shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation,
- (b) that the lengths of the Cardiff-Llangurig and Raglan-Llandovery Trunk Roads to be superseded shall ceuse to be trunk roads as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Brecon (who will become the highway authority responsible for those lengths) that the Brecon By-pass is open for through traffic, and
- 2. An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him:
 - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,

 - (b) to stop up highways,(c) to construct new highways,
 - (d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and(e) to provide new means of access to premises,
- all at Brecon aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Brecon as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
