The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under sections 3 (6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958.

Viz: The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 5) Order 1973.

This Order provides that the goods listed in the Schedule shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 1st January 1974 or such earlier day as is specified.

The Order comes into operation on 8th March 1973 and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1973 No. 401.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales intends to make an Order under sections 72 (3) and 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h. in the length of road specified in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

That length of the Fishguard—Bangor Trunk Road A487, known in part as Dovey Bridge Road and in part as Doll Street or Heol Doll at Machynlleth in the County of Montgomery which extends from a point 180 yards south of the centre line of the Machynlleth Station Railway Bridge in a northerly direction for a distance of 255 yards.
