

SCHEDULE 1

1 Road or length of road	2 Direction
1. <i>Avery Farm Row</i>	from north-east to south-west
2. <i>Ebury Square</i> , the south-eastern arm	from north-east to south-west
3. <i>Ebury Street</i> , between Semley Place and Eccleston Street	from south-west to north-east
4. <i>Elizabeth Street</i> , between Ebury Street and Buckingham Palace Road	from north-west to south-east
5. <i>Semley Place</i>	from south-east to north-west

SCHEDULE 2

- Buckingham Palace Road*
 - the north-west side
 - between the south-western kerb-line of the north-west to south-east arm of Grosvenor Gardens lying opposite Grosvenor Place and the north-eastern kerb-line of the unnamed road leading to Eccleston Place ;
 - between the south-western kerb-line of Eccleston Street and a point opposite the north-eastern side of the entrance to the garage situated adjacent to No. 126 Buckingham Palace Road ;
 - between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 158 and 160 Buckingham Palace Road and the north-eastern kerb-line of Elizabeth Street ;
 - the south-east side, between a point 65 feet north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Semley Place and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 202 and 204 Buckingham Palace Road.

SCHEDULE 3

- Buckingham Palace Road* the north-west side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 72 to 78 and No. 88 Buckingham Palace Road and a point 100 feet north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Eccleston Street.

- Buckingham Palace Road* the north-west side, between the south-western kerb-line of Elizabeth Street and a point 100 feet south-west of that kerb-line.

- Eccleston Bridge* the north-east side, between the south-eastern kerb-line of Buckingham Palace Road and a point 150 feet south-east of that kerb-line.
- Eccleston Street* the north-east side
 - between the north-western kerb-line of Buckingham Palace Road and a point 110 feet north-west of that kerb-line ;
