SECTION IV

Terminal Grants for Officers of Flag and General Rank

5. Officers of Flag and General Rank of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines, who retire from the Active List on or after 1st January 1972, and are awarded retired pay under sections II or III of this Schedule, may be awarded a tax-free terminal grant of 3 times the annual rate of retired pay awarded. The terminal grant will be awarded under the general conditions of award laid down in Orders in Council current at the time of the Officer's retirement.
