HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Lon Tyllwyd Junction—Llanfarian Village Side Roads) Order 1971.

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Llanfarian Village in the County of Cardigan to make

under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order which will—

(a) authorise him—

- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter Lon Tyllwyd;
- (ii) to stop up Lon Tyllwyd;
- (iii) to construct a new highway to connect Lon Tyllwyd with the Trunk Road, all at Llanfarian aforesaid and

(b) provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Cardigan as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
