When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle:

(a) in the following lengths of Station Road between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday:

(i) west side, from its junction with George Street southwards for a distance of 53 yards;

(ii) east side, from its junction with Mill Road southwards for a distance of 101 yards.

(b) in the following lengths of Station Road for a longer period than 1 hour (no return within 1 hour) between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday:

(i) west side, from a point 53 yards south of its junction with George Street southwards for a distance of

88 vards:

(ii) east side, from a point 101 yards south of its junction with Mill Road southwards for a distance of 41 yards.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- (c) collecting or delivering postal packets for the Post Office;

and, where necessary, in connection with-

- (d) the maintenance of the road, and
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The restriction in (b) above will not apply to vehicles displaying an authorised disabled person's badge issued by a local authority.

Full details of the proposal are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the lengths of road in question and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at the offices of the Okehampton Borough Council, Town Hall, Okehampton, or at room G.55b, County Hall, Exeter.

Victoria Avenue—on both sides between a point 360 feet west of its junction with the western side of Northbrook Road and a point 60 feet west of its junction with the western side of its eastern junction with Prospect Crescent.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers,
- (b) loading and unloading goods,

and, where necessary, in connection with:

(c) the maintenance of the roads, and

(d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.
