MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

City of Manchester (Crumpsall) Smoke Control Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Manchester acting by the Council of the said City, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 12th February 1973, made an Order entitled the City of Manchester (Crumpsall) Smoke Control Order, 1973, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order including the exemptions referred to in paragraph 7 below

and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st July 1974, or before a later date determined under the provisions of the Clean Air Act, 1956.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Policy and Finance Section (Room 116), Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Manchester, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 23rd March 1973, and at Crumpsall District Library, Bury Old Road, Manchester, M8 7LN, during the same period.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

6. Subject to certain conditions, persons incurring expenditure in connection with a private dwelling in order to comply with the Order are entitled to a grant towards that expenditure provided that the expenditure is incurred after the confirmation and before the coming into operation of the Order, and with the approval of the Corporation. After the Order has been confirmed, such persons should before any work is carried out or any expenditure incurred, submit their proposals to the Clean Air Section of the Health Department in the Town Hall, Manchester.

7. The parts of the proposed smoke control area coloured pink on the map referred to in paragraph 4 above have been surveyed for action under Part III of the Housing Act 1957. As the Smoke Control Order does not prohibit the emission of smoke from premises in those parts of the smoke control area coloured pink on the map the grant referred to in paragraph 6 will not be payable in respect of dwellings in those parts of the smoke control area.

8. If the Order is confirmed notices of confirmation will be published in the Press and copies of the notice posted in the smoke control area.

SCHEDULE

The area to which the Order relates is situated in the Crumpsall area of the City of Manchester and is bounded on the north by Meade Hill Road, Blackley New Road, Old Market Street and Middleton Old Road; on the east by Rochdale Road; on the south by Harpurhey Road; Waterloo Street, Springfield and Crescent Road, and on the west by Bury Old Road, and the City boundary.

The authorised fuels include anthracite coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st October 1974, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
