

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish part of the public right of way running from Hollin Lane to Denby Dale Road, Crigglestone, and create an alternative highway in lieu.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, 18 St. John's North, Wakefield, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., on Monday to Friday.

This Order becomes operative as from the date on which it is certified by Wakefield Rural District Council that the provisions of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, within six weeks from the 30th March 1973, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

#### WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

*The Warwickshire County Council (Footpath R174, Dunchurch) Public Path Diversion Order, 1973*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), made on the 29th day of March 1973, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Warwickshire County Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert that length of footpath R174 which runs diagonally across the field which has a frontage to the south side of the trunk road A.45 immediately east of the property known as "High Hedges", Coventry Road. The new footpath will run in a north-easterly direction along the north-westerly side of this field for a distance of approximately 135 metres, then across the field on a line parallel to (but away from) Coventry Road and finally in a south-westerly direction along the south-easterly side of the field for approximately 112 metres.

A copy of the Order and of the map contained in it may be inspected free of charge at the office of the Clerk of the Council, Shire Hall, Warwick, and at the office of the Clerk of Rugby Rural District Council, 24 Warwick Street, Rugby, on Mondays to Fridays inclusive during normal office hours.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the undersigned at the Shire Hall, Warwick, not later than 27th April 1973, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representation or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Warwickshire County Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to him with the Order.
