Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 2 (1) of the Statutory Orders (Special Procedure) Act 1945, that it is the intention of the Secretary of State for the Home Department to lay before Parliament The Kent County Council (Brook, Chatham) Compulsory Purchase Order 1972 confirmed by him on 19th March 1973 under the provisions of section 159 (1) of the Local Government Act 1933, section 25 (1) of the Justices of the Peace Act 1949 and the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) Act 1946 1946.

The Trunk Road (Tongwynlais to Nantgarw, Glamorgan) (Prohibition of Foot Passengers) Order 1973

STAGE I

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State intends to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding in that length of the new section of the Cardiff—Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A.470),

from Tongwynlais to Nantgarw in the County of Glamorgan, including the slip roads, which extends from a point 150 yards south of the centre of the bridge over the Whitchurch to Tongwynlais Road, A.4054, in a northwesterly direction for a distance of approximately 3.0 miles to the centre point of the Nantgarw Roundabout.

The proposed prohibition would not apply to the following footwars:

ing footways:

(1) that footway at the south-east slip road to the Nantgarw Roundabout which extends between the cattle grid and the Roundabout,

(2) that footway on the north-west slip road to the Radyr Interchange which extends from the footway's junction with the principal road leading to Taffs Well in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow pedestrians to walk on the trunk road in any of the following circumstances:

- (a) to investigate any accident which has occurred on or near the trunk road;
- (b) to avoid or prevent an accident or to obtain or give help required as the result of an accident or emergency provided as little danger or inconvenience as possible is caused to other traffic;
- (c) where it is necessary to do so as the result of a vehicle stopping due to a breakdown or other defect or the vehicle being prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside the driver's control.

 (d) to recover or move any object which has fallen on
- to the road;
- (e) in exercise of their duties as members of the police service, fire service or ambulance service;
- (f) to carry out maintenance to the road or services therein; or
- (g) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties. A copy of the proposed Order together with plans may be seen during normal office hours
