SECTION III

Revision of Modified Family Pensions

7. The following changes will be made in the provision for the grant of family pensions made in earlier Orders in Council when the death of the husband is due to service and the family is awarded an attributable pension:

- (a) A widow receiving a modified family pension is, from 1st December 1972 eligible for a family pension at the rates as specified in Section II Clauses 5 and 6.
- (b) The family pension will be abated by the following amount if a widow is receiving an attributable pension as the widow of an officer:

Children. Children's pension will not be subject to such reductions.

8. *Minimum rates of Family Pensions where an attributable award is paid.* If the rates of family pension calculated in accordance with Clause 5 would be less than those set out in Clause 6 the latter will be payable.

9. *Definition of Rank for the Purposes of Minimum Awards of Family Pensions.* Rank for the purpose of Clauses 6 and 7 will be as follows:

(a) *Officers.* The rank shall be the substantive rank held by the Officer on his retirement, provided that unless the Officer is invalided, the rank has been held on the Active List for the following minimum period:

- (i) Admiral/General, Royal Marines 1 year
- (ii) All other officers 2 years
