

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A COMBINED LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS AND TO ABSTRACT WATER.

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Essex River Authority by Lt. Col. H. Boggis Rolfe of Colletts Farm, Wormingford, for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of a tributary of the River Stour by means of impounding works at Grid Reference TL 9407/3230 and to abstract 5 million gallons of water per year from the said inland water at or near that point.

The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 2.3 million gallons.

APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS.

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Somerset River Authority by the Sherborne Castle Estates, Digby Estate, Sherborne, for a licence to impede the flow of the River Yeo at its outfall from the Sherborne Lake at NGR-ST-648167 in the Parish of Castleton by means of improving and altering an existing weir and to abstract from the said inland water by regulated release during periods of drought.

The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 120 million gallons.

Improvements by dredging and the adaption of the existing Sherborne Lake to regulate the River Yeo will alleviate flooding in the Yeo Valley and increase facilities for amenity usage.

GREAT HARWOOD URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

The Great Harwood Urban District (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Great Harwood Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 22nd March 1973, made an Order entitled the Great Harwood Urban District (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1973, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of

any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st August 1974 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 4th May 1973.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
